POLICY BULLETIN NO 3-1

**SUBJECT: INSTALLATION OF POLE-MOUNTED SERVICES FOR MOBILE HOMES,
RV'S AND CENTER POLE UNITS**

I. POLICY:

A 100 amp, 200 amp and 40 amp RV single phase 120/240V pole-mounted service shall be provided at cost by the Cooperative to the member desiring this type of service. A member may elect to install his own service on a Cooperative provided pole. The Cooperative will provide a guy wire and anchor if it is necessary.

II. PROCEDURE:

A. If Cooperative installs service:

1. The Cooperative shall, after payments and other requirements have been arranged, install a pole and all necessary service equipment.
2. The cost for this service (see Schedule of Fees) will approximately cover the installation.
3. The member will be required to have the installed service inspected by a qualified inspector from an approved listing.

B. If member installs service:

Member may elect to install his own service on a Cooperative provided pole. In this case the member must have the service approved by a qualified electrical inspection agency and meet any other requirements listed on the Cooperative's specification sheet before the service can be connected. The Cooperative must install the pole and charge a fee (see Schedule of Fees) to cover the cost.

C. Member must furnish and be responsible for his own meter base, either purchased from the Cooperative or from a Cooperative-approved manufacturer's list.

D. The service and all maintenance will remain the property and responsibility of the member.

- E. All maintenance and repair work on the service and the meter base will be billed to the member according to Policy #3-11.
