POLICY BULLETIN NO 3-8

SUBJECT: INSTALLATION OF TEMPORARY SERVICES

I. POLICY:

The cooperative will serve a temporary service for all members needing service for construction purposes only. A service of this type may be energized for one (1) year only.

II. PROCEDURE:

- A. For construction sites where permanent electric service will be later required, a temporary electric service will be energized by the cooperative under the following provisions:
 - 1. The location, size and type (underground or overhead) of the building's future permanent electrical entrance must be firmly determined before the temporary service location can be mutually agreed upon.
 - 2. The member must erect a structure for the temporary service equipment that meets or exceeds the cooperative's specifications.
 - 3. The member must install the temporary service equipment according to the current National Electrical Safety Code and meet any other requirements listed on the cooperative's specification sheet.
 - 4. The installation must be approved by a qualified electrical inspection agency before the service can be connected.
- B. For construction sites where permanent electrical service will not be required upon completion, a temporary service will be energized by the cooperative under the following provisions:
 - 1. The location of the temporary structure shall be mutually agreed upon.
 - 2. Requirements 2, 3, and 4 of A above shall also be met.
 - 3. The charge of installing and removing cooperative facilities to the temporary structure shall be computed by doubling the labor and overhead costs as estimated from the staking sheets.
